LeadBoston 2022 Cohort Norms

- Have technology ready, camera and microphone on during virtual sessions
- Feedback will be collected and shared regularly for continuous improvement
- Come to program days prepared to actively participate and be fully engaged
- Limit multi-tasking (i.e. email, phone, work chats) during sessions; breaks will be built in
- Have a notebook and pen handy for written reflection
- Interact and get to know people in between classes
- Facilitators will help uphold dialogue practices and call-in participants when needed
- Interact on YW Boston Connect regularly; turn on your notifications

- LeadBoston 2022 will be hybrid, starting virtually for January-March, and tentatively transitioning to in-person for the remainder of the year. This is subject to change based on safety and space considerations, and we will communicate any changes as soon as possible.
